INFORMATION FOR PROSPECTIVE INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

- I. NORTHERN OKLAHOMA COLLEGE- A state 2-year college was established in 1901. The main campus is located at Tonkawa, Oklahoma, a city of approximately 4,000 people, about 90 miles north of Oklahoma City. The campus in Enid is located about 100 miles northwest of Oklahoma City on the east side of Enid, Oklahoma. The campus in Stillwater is located about 75 miles northeast of Oklahoma City in Stillwater directly across the street from Oklahoma State University. All four seasons are felt in Oklahoma with extremes ranging from 38 degrees C in summer to -18 degrees C in the winter. The average precipitation is about 30 inches per year. The college academic program consists of a fall (August-December) and a spring (January-May) semester and an eight-week (June-July) summer session.

- II. ADMISSION POLICIES: The following items are required to be considered for admission and must be submitted to the Registrar's Office 60 days before the applicant plans to arrive on the Tonkawa, Enid, or Stillwater Campus. Applications cannot be considered until all of the following have been submitted to the Registrar's Office. When the application has been processed and the student has been fully admitted, an I-20 will be issued.
 1. APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION. Print from Website.
 2. ACADEMIC RECORDS: OFFICIAL transcripts of the applicant's entire academic record in secondary school and university, including grades received each year of study, degree certificates, and examination certificates. Transfer applicants must present evidence of a 2.00 grade point average (on a 4.00 system). Transcripts from institutions outside of the United States must be submitted to World Education Services for conversion into the United States system. Students may look at www.wes.org for information.
 3. ENGLISH PROFICIENCY CERTIFICATION: All applicants whose native language is not English must present proof of English proficiency in the form of test scores on the TOEFL. A minimum score of 500 is required. Provisional admission may be granted if the applicant has scored 460 and has studied at an approved English language school for a minimum of 12 weeks after taking the TOEFL.
 4. FINANCIAL STATEMENT: Before being admitted to Northern Oklahoma College a foreign student must provide specific, documentary evidence of sufficient funds to cover each year of intended stay (\$8546.00 per calendar year). Documentary evidence of financial support must be returned with the application for admission.
 5. INSURANCE VERIFICATION: Because the cost of medical care in the U.S. is usually much higher than in other countries, all foreign students are required to purchase insurance before registering for classes. Verification of insurance is required.
 6. DEPOSIT: A \$5000.00 cash deposit is required before a student may enroll for classes. An I-20 will not be issued until the deposit has been received at Northern. Visa, MasterCard, Cashiers Check or Money Order payable to Northern Oklahoma College are accepted.
 7. DORM APPLICATION: Print from Website. Stillwater students must apply for housing through Oklahoma State University.

2. FINANCIAL AID: Financial aid from Northern Oklahoma College is NOT available for foreign students.
3. STUDENT LOANS: There are no student loans available to foreign students.
4. PART –TIME EMPLOYMENT: The United States Immigration laws do not permit a foreign student to accept employment off –campus unless a work permit has been issued by U. S. Immigration. If available, part –time employment is allowed on campus only at no more than 20 hours per week.
